

The valedictory session featured inspiring keynote addresses that underscored the importance of agri-innovation and grassroots impact. With energy, vision, and momentum, the cohort graduates now move forward, ready to create meaningful change across India's agricultural landscape.

Program Update


Agri Cohort 2024-25

- Since January, the cohort engaged in 120+ one-on-one Ice Breaking Sessions with mentors, fostering deep connections and personalized guidance
- 12 Huddle sessions encouraged peer learning and experience sharing across the cohort.
- 4 Knowledge Building Sessions (KBS) delivered sector-specific insights and growth strategies from domain experts.
- 3 Leadership Circle (LC) sessions provided a reflective space for founders to discuss leadership challenges and collective solutions.
- The Demo Day showcased 15 high-potential startups, resulting in 31 investor and mentor connection requests, demonstrating strong external interest.
- The program culminated in a Valedictory Session held on 1st July, featuring inspiring keynote addresses by:
 - Will Poole, Co-founder & Managing Partner, Capria Ventures
 - Devendra Gupta, Co-founder & CEO, Ecozen Solutions
- Both leaders shared compelling insights on innovation, resilience, and building scalable impact ventures, setting an aspirational tone for the cohort's next phase.





KBS SESSION



Knowledge Building Session with Aishwarya Malhi: Fundraising with Strategy & Storytelling

- In a high-impact Knowledge Building Session curated for the AFI Agri Cohort 2024–25, Aishwarya Malhi, Co-founder of Rebalance, shared practical and strategic insights on navigating the fundraising journey for agri-tech startups. Rebalance is a platform that supports underrepresented founders by helping them access capital and leadership resources.
- The session focused on equipping early-stage founders with tools and mindset shifts needed to attract investment. Aishwarya emphasized the importance of building commercially viable ventures and moving beyond reliance on grants by strengthening business models, market clarity, and pitch delivery.

- Understanding investor expectations and building alignment
- Shifting from grant dependency to commercial sustainability
- Avoiding common fundraising pitfalls faced by impact-led startups
- Clearly communicating unit economics and technological edge
- Crafting pitch decks that blend impact storytelling with strong business fundamentals
- Startups from the cohort also introduced their solutions across areas like drone technology, IoT-based irrigation systems, rapid soil diagnostics, and traceable dairy supply chains. The session highlighted the breadth of innovation emerging from the agri-tech space and reinforced the importance of strategy, scalability, and storytelling in successful fundraising.



KBS SESSION



Knowledge Building Session with Sachin Nandwana: Scaling Farmer-Centric Innovation

- The AFI Agri Cohort 2024–25 had the opportunity to engage with Sachin Nandwana, Co-founder and CEO of BigHaat, in an insightful Knowledge Building Session focused on building digital-first, farmer-centric solutions. BigHaat has been at the forefront of transforming Indian agriculture through tech-enabled input delivery, advisory, and market linkages.
- · In this engaging session, Sachin shared the inspiring journey of BigHaat, from its early days to becoming one of India's leading agri-tech platforms. He emphasized how digital innovation can drive meaningful change at the grassroots level when solutions are tailored to the needs of farmers.

- Lessons from BigHaat's growth journey and evolving product strategy
- Importance of understanding farmers as customers and building trust through localized solutions
- · Leveraging technology to solve real-world problems across the agri value chain
- · Using partnerships and platforms to scale reach and impact
- · The session was highly interactive, with cohort founders asking sharp and thoughtful questions about customer acquisition, product adoption, and rural scalability. Sachin showed genuine interest in the startups' work and generously offered support through BigHaat's network and infrastructure, creating opportunities for future collaboration.

<u>Demo Day Highlights – Agri Cohort 2024–25</u>

• The Agri Cohort 2024–25 Demo Day was held on 28th June, marking a significant milestone in the cohort's journey. After months of intensive mentorship, learning sessions, and peer engagement, 15 high-impact startups took the spotlight to pitch their innovative agri-tech solutions to a curated panel of investors, mentors, and ecosystem leaders. The event served as a powerful platform to showcase their progress and potential, setting the stage for future collaborations and scale.

- The Demo Day marked the culmination of an intensive support journey for the Agri Cohort, showcasing the progress of 15 high-potential startups working in areas such as precision farming, climate-resilient solutions, agri-fintech, and rural livelihoods.
- · Each startup delivered a focused pitch to a curated audience of investors, mentors, and ecosystem leaders, highlighting their traction, innovation, and future vision.
- The event saw enthusiastic participation from leading investors and ecosystem partners, including: IIMA Ventures, Upaya Social Ventures, ARAM Partners, Zetta Farms, Villgro, Excluto, Yunus Social Business, Social Alpha, Next Bharat Ventures, Sanchi Connect, Caret Capital, Caspian, Fluid Ventures, Marico Innovation Foundation, O2 Angels Network, and Green Trunk Ventures.
- The Demo Day generated 31 formal connection requests, signaling strong interest from investors and potential mentors in the cohort's work and growth potential.
- · Overall, the event reinforced the ecosystem's confidence in supporting agri-innovation and highlighted the startups' readiness to scale their solutions for greater impact.


<u>Keynote Insights from Will Poole: Embracing AI for the Future of Agri Innovation</u>

• At the Valedictory Session of the AFI Agri Cohort 2024–25, we were honoured to hear from Will Poole, Co-founder and Managing Partner of Capria Ventures, who delivered a forward-looking keynote address on the transformative power of AI for emerging market entrepreneurs. Will drew from his global experience working with startups across Africa, Latin America, and Asia, sharing practical insights on how founders can begin their AI journey—regardless of how far behind they feel today.

- Most founders are still early in their Al journey, with only 20% actively using generative or agentic Al. Now is the time to learn and start integrating it.
- · Al hasn't used all the data, there's massive opportunity in private, real-time, and farm-level data that startups already possess.
- · Startups can gain an edge by building AI tools trained on their own unique datasets, rather than competing with big tech.
- · Agentic AI is here—AI systems that act independently are already transforming core business functions using low-code and no-code platforms.
- · Founders were encouraged to act now and use the data and context they uniquely understand to build AI-led solutions.

<u>Keynote Insights from Devendra Gupta: Compassion at the Core of Entrepreneurship</u>

• At the Valedictory Session of the AFI Agri Cohort 2024–25, Devendra Gupta, Co-founder and CEO of Ecozen, delivered an inspiring keynote that brought the spotlight back to what truly drives meaningful entrepreneurship — compassion for the customer. In a space often dominated by talk of scale, ambition, and strategy, his message was a refreshing reminder that the heart of innovation lies in empathy.

- Businesses are not built out of ego or ambition. They are built out of compassion for the customer.
- True vision starts with something that inspires you not just your team or investors.
- Emotional connection with the customer is essential to build impactful, lasting solutions.
- If your customers are not at the center of every decision, your journey from zero to one will remain difficult.
- The ultimate test of your vision is whether you keep going in the face of failure that's when compassion becomes your compass.
