




AFI's Mission

- Recently raised ₹7 crore in a seed round led by Samved Ventures with participation from LetsVenture, Indigram Labs and IIM-C Innovation Park.
- Funding will help expand from 2,000 to 5,000+ Didis, strengthening its rural livelihood mission.

Agri Vijay

- Led by Vimal Panchwani, Agri Vijay is India's first renewable-energy marketplace for farmers.
- Helps farmers adopt affordable, climate-friendly energy solutions to boost income and sustainability.
- Has raised ₹2.47 crore across pre-seed and seed rounds from IRMA, Indigram Labs and other notable investors.
- Capital will accelerate expansion into more rural communities, enabling energy-independent agriculture.


